Fly Fishing

Golfing

Bobsled Rides

Each sled is piloted by a professional driver and reaches speeds of up to 65 miles per hour. This is one of the only rides of its kind in North America.



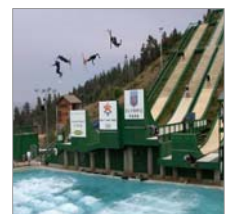
Mountain Biking

Horseback Riding

Wander along forest trails to spectacular ridge-top views, seated comfortably atop the saddle of your well-trained horse. Your guide will offer you basic instructions on saddling and riding techniques while you enjoy the best views in the range where wildflowers abound.



Hot Air Ballooning

Climb into a hand-woven basket suspended beneath a kaleidoscope of colorful fabric; lift off and gently ascend towards the clouds. You will capture the feeling of flying as you ride the air currents above Park City into the cool mountain morning. There is no other feeling like this, or a more spectacular view.



Helicopter Tour

Get a birds-eye view of the area in a unique helicopter ride and experience the Wasatch Front from a whole new perspective. Fly above the canyons and observe the scenic views of the snow-capped peaks, mountain lakes and streams, and granite rock cliffs followed by an aerial tour of the Park City area.



Biathlon Shoot

Imagine lying on the ground and shooting targets with an air rifle from a thirty-foot range. Add a little running or biking to the competition and you'll see just how difficult this sport can be. No biathlon experience is necessary for this activity!



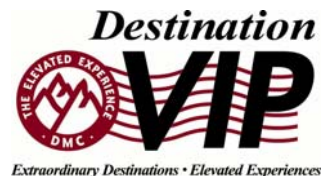
Hiking
